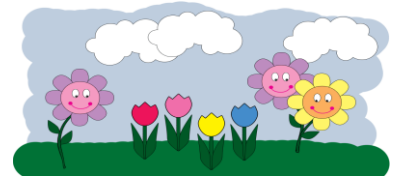

The focus of the class will be two main topics: **typing skills** and **navigating interfaces**. Both of these focus will be geared towards test preparation (**PARCC**) and skill development. By the end of the 8 weeks, students should have improved in their typing (accuracy and speed) and build confidence in taking online tests.
